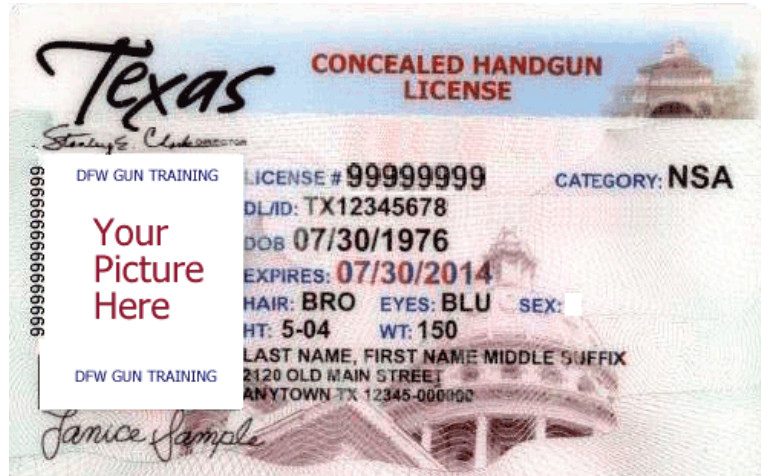


What Does This Little Card Mean?



The person who carries this card by force of Texas law...

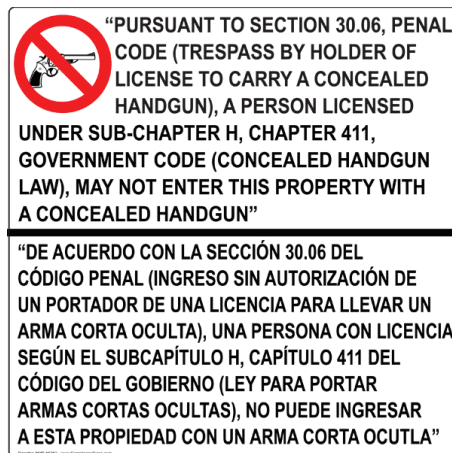
... has passed a Texas DPS background check.

... has taken 10 hours of training on subjects including use of force, nonviolent dispute resolution, handgun use, and safe and proper storage of handguns and ammunition.

... may be an honorably retired police officer.

... must have their gun concealed in your business.

What Does This Sign Really Say?



It says you do not want law-abiding, trained, honest gun owners, their families or guests to spend their money in your establishment.
